

CARE HEALTH LEADERS PROGRAM

Program Details

In this 9-month program, CARE Health Leaders learn about health inequities and solutions to create health equity at the neighborhood level. Workshops focus on health in Hartford neighborhoods, community engagement, leadership development, and project planning and development. Participants are required to work with a small group to plan and execute a health project in their neighborhood. Participants are required to attend regular workshop sessions and participate regularly with their groups from January through September 2026. Participants are required to spend approximately 5 hours per week participating in the program.



Schedule

Between January and May, HLs meet biweekly on Wednesday from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

From June to September, HLs meet monthly on Wednesday from 5:30-7:30 p.m.

Participants are eligible to receive a total of \$2700 for completing program requirements. Meals are provided at in-person meetings.
